

**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 25/2007**

Under the power vested in him by Article 50 paragraph 4 of the Basic Law of the Macao Special Administrative Region, and pursuant to the terms of Article 72 of Decree-Law No. 40/95/M, of 14 August, the Chief Executive determines the promulgation of the present executive order:
